



Cookie Policy

Like many web sites, www.bema.co.uk uses cookies. Cookies are data files that are stored on your computer. They may contain information that enables a web site promoter to identify each time a user visits a web site, to see how the users are interacting with the web site and to record how frequently they are returning. The cookies that we use do not contain personal data about you.

When you come to www.bema.co.uk, the server attaches a small text file to your hard drive - that is the cookie. This file is unique to you, and it can be read by the server or your browser software. This unique cookie tells BEMA Ltd. that your computer has been used to re-enter www.bema.co.uk. We may also use cookies to authenticate and record your acceptance to other applicable terms and conditions. Finally, we may also use cookies to authenticate and record your acceptance to the handling of other information, including personal data that you may voluntarily provide from time to time through www.bema.co.uk in accordance with our Privacy Policy.

Cookies cannot be executed as code or used to deliver a virus. Other servers cannot read them and personal information cannot be gathered from them. They are simply an identifier shared between you and BEMA Ltd.; we do not share them with anyone outside of BEMA Ltd.

If you do not want to accept cookies from www.bema.co.uk or other sites, your browser software should allow you to decline to accept cookies. Look, for example, in the Preferences or Internet Options features of your browser to do this. However, you should know that if you disable acceptance of cookies or modify your cookies in any manner, you may not be able to access www.bema.co.uk or specific information, materials and/or services available on www.bema.co.uk.
